

How & Why to Get Vaccinated

No vaccine is 100 percent effective, but they do prevent severe illness, hospitalization and death. Vaccinations were not made to prevent mild symptoms - but keep people from dying.

Adults are 14 times more likely to die from Covid-19 if they are not fully vaccinated. Young people are 10 times more likely to die from Covid-19 if they are not fully vaccinated. -CDC

97% of hospitalizations and 99.5% of COVID deaths are unvaccinated people.

How to Get Vaccinated

StarMed: Medical insurance is not required and the cost is free. The only information requested is name, address and birthday. <https://starmed.care/es/vacuna/>
